

 - No ground monitoring stations have been installed on the proposed flight path for North runway in the Portmarnock area under the New flight path
 - The DAA have not used the new flight path over Portmarnock to allow residents accurately access the true noise impact of the proposed flight path on residents effected in the Portmarnock area,
 - The insulation grant of 20K will not cover the true cost of insulating the houses.
 - The proposed night time flights will predominately be used for refuelling of aircraft this will not benefit the Irish economy in any way as there is no duty on Aviation fuel
 - The DAA have said there is a possibility of up to 15 degrees deviation of the flightpath which would divert flights over the Robswall area of Malahide
 - The flight contour maps do not encompass the noise impact of flightpath deviations
 - There is probably 500 houses in Robswall and another 500 in the Portmarnock area directly impacted by proposed flightpath
 - ANCA do not even show houses eligible for insulation under the new runway. All references are for the existing runway
