Malahide Community Forum is the umbrella organisation for all of the Malahide area's Residents Associations and therefore represents a large majority of the residents of Malahide. MCF Makes the following observations in relation to this Draft Decision.

MCF fully supports the Draft Decision to limit night flights, i.e. from 23.00 to 06.59, to 13,000 p.a. as this would substantially improve human health in the population living in the area around the airport, by significantly reducing sleep disturbance.

The adverse impact of sleep disturbance is now well understood by the WHO and other such organisations.
