



Subject: Date: Public Consultation on Aircraft Noise (Dublin Airport)

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Dear Sir or Madam,

I hereby wish to make a submission to the public consultation on aircraft noise at Dublin Airport.

I object to the proposed lifting of night-time restrictions at Dublin Airport due to the following reasons:

- 1. I am a resident of Seapark, Malahide and I object to the significant increase in night-time noise which would result from the new plans for the airport, particularly the fifteen flights between 6 and 7 am when flights are operating in the Easterly direction.
- 2. I understand that many airports in Europe, Frankfurt and Zurich for example, can operate successfully with night-time restrictions on flights. There is no reason why Dublin airport could not follow that model.
- 3. Insufficient consideration appears to have been given to the adverse health effects of excessive aircraft noise on the people in the new flight-path which would result from the plans for the airport.

I appeal to ANCA (Aircraft Noise Competent Authority) to have more regard for the health and general quality of life of the people who would be affected by the new plans. Please scale back the plans for night-time flights.
