My name is James O Connor of Blackberry Rise Portmarnock Co Dublin.

On 18th December 2020, the airport authority for Dublin Airport (daa) submitted a planning application to Fingal County Council Planning Authority seeking to amend prior planning conditions associated with night-time aircraft activity at the airport. The application relates to night time use of the new north parallel runway and changes to permitted night-time aircraft movements across the entire airport.

My house is directly under the new parallel runway. I think the original planning application gave the airport authority sufficient scope to increase flights at Dublin airport during reasonable hours. I think this application to ignore the original planning conditions and seek to extend the hours will create an unpleasant noise environment for those living under the flight path.

I would ask Fingal County council to reject this application on the ground of excessive noise being imposed on residents during these hours and ask them to comply with the otigional planning conditions.
