



I wish to make the following observations to the draft decision to ABP-314485-22.

Under the Noise Quota Scheme (NQS) the hours as proposed between 23.00 and 0659 inclusive to be amended to 23.30 and 5.59 inclusive. This will allow more flexibility on the number of nighttime flights while maintaining the noise quota to reasonable hours for local residents. Under the annual aircraft movement limit of 13,000 as proposed between the nighttime hours of 23.00 and 06.59 to be amended to the nighttime hours of 23.59 and 05.30.

This is to allow the first and last wave of flights from Dublin based airlines to maintain a reasonable level of flights while ensuring the frequency of flights is not over done during the aircraft movement hours of 23.59 to 05.30. As Dublin is now a significant hub for USA flights many of these inbound USA flights as landing between the hours of 05.30 and 10.00 and the proposed movement hours will hinder these flights unnecessarily. Ireland is one hour behind the majority of European cities and the proposed movement hours will restrict a lot of existing early European departures.
