Dear sir/Madam

I wish to submit an objection to the changes to the night time flight hours as the noise is already unbearable. We only live 170metres from the new runway and we got the same noise insulation package as people who live 2 kilometres away from the Runway. There is talk of a bedroom insulation scheme, What are the exact details of that? Is there any proof it will work? What insulation is going to keep the noise out at this close range? It needs to be researched not just talked about.

Regarding the proposed quota system,

- Will it be calculated 12 monthly or quarterly? Are we expected to believe that when they reach the quota even if there is two months left in the year that they will stop flying at night? ANCA is only a new body set up, What power does ANCA have to enforce the rules? The punishment will probably only be a small fine. DAA has constantly breached the 65 flights a night rule in the past and nobody ever done anything about it.

These are all very important questions and they must be answered before any decision is made. I don't think a 14 week period at the end of a pandemic is a long enough time to gather all the information needed to make the correct decision .
