We wish to inform you that we object in the strongest possible terms to the proposal for a second runway at Dublin Airport.

We do so because of the flagrant disregard in the planning process. Whereas a planning permission has been granted for the runway the “divergent flightpaths” which the Airport Authority now propose to implement, as a result of this proposed runway, have NOT been the subject of a planning permission. The Airport’s plans as they are proceeding are in breach of planning laws.

It is extraordinary that a primary State-backed authority charged with major responsibilities can proceed in this way without complying with planning conditions that are imposed on the rest of us.

We trust you will take this factual and disturbing consideration on board and ensure that this development will be immediately ceased. If it is to be reconsidered please ensure that the planning laws will be adhered to.

We would appreciate an acknowledgement to this email and an assurance from you that you will make representations to ensure that due process will apply to this development.
