We wish to inform you that we object in the strongest possible terms to the proposal for a second runway at Dublin Airport. We do so because of the blatant disregard for the planning process in relation to the so-called “divergent routes” which were NEVER the subject of a planning application.

Whereas a planning permission has been granted for the runway, the “divergent flightpaths” which the Airport Authority now propose to implement have NOT been the subject of a planning permission.

The Airport’s plans as they are proceeding are clearly in breach of planning laws and as such should not be allowed to proceed. It is extraordinary that a primary State-backed authority can proceed in this way having a blatant disregard for the planning conditions that are imposed on the rest of us.

We would appreciate your sending us an acknowledgement of this email and an assurance that all matters relating to this development will adhere to the necessary legal and planning conventions.
