I would like to formally object to any proposed changes to the planning permission for the new runway at Dublin Airport,

We are already experiencing high noise levels in the Hollystown area and even though there are no flights currently allowed during the night this happens on a regular basis and disturbs our sleep.

This is particularly bad in the summer time at 4-5 am in the morning. During the pandemic it was noticeable how much more peaceful our environment was, with no planes flying consistently over our houses.

As the world travel habits return I can only see this situation worsen.. We should not compound this by allowing these changes..

Our mental wellbeing is been severely disrupted by this noise with no apparent let up or innovation to reduce noise levels from these aircraft.

In addition in Hollystown we have been offered no relief in the form of support to retrofit noise barriers in our houses to improve the sound in our area.

This late request to overturn the conditions for the planning of the runway **MUST BE REJECTED.**
