I am strongly objecting to the proposal for 65+ night flights at Dublin Airport which is in direct contravention of the conditions attached to the planning permission for the second runway granted to Dublin Airport in 2007. I live in Holywell Swords and as it is the noise levels of planes flying overhead are a nuisance but to increase it to the levels suggested in these proposals would seriously impact on our standard of living and is I believe an unlawful act as it contravenes our current legal rights re noise pollution given the current legislation on noise level restrictions both at national and EU level. Many people bought their homes here based on the conditions attached to the 2007 planning permissions. To breach them and contravene them will seriously and adversely affect market values of the affected properties in the vicinity of the airport. This economic adverse effect coupled with the legal points made above re right to peace during the hours of 11-7 must take precedence here.
