Lufthansa Group supports the Draft Regulatory decision made by ANCA on the 11th November 2021 to remove the 65 movements/night cap. We are also in favour of a NQS noise quota system, which is common in other airports. Please note – the common approach is set at QC of 6.5 hours and not 8 hours.

The removal of the 65 movements/night cap ensures our early departures can continue to feed our Hubs Frankfurt, Munich and Zurich. These flights remain crucial for important intercontinental connections to the North Atlantic, Africa and Asian Pacific region. Over 70% of our guests connect onwards, many of whom are business travellers.
