We strongly object to any modifications to the previously Ann Bord Pleanala granted planning permission in 2007.

As it stands we, living in Streamstown on the Malahide Road, experience considerable noise disruption and vibration.

The vibration is at it's worst early mornings and in particular at approx. 10am every Saturday morning.

The original planning process was thorough and the decision was made by ABP.

The current DAA application, which will inevitably be appealed to ABP, is challenging the very carefully thought out decision by ABP some years ago.

All we are seeing is more and more flights which already equals more and more noise/vibration.

If Fingal Co Co grant the application it could result in a dangerous precedent that will allow the DAA to lodge yet another application to change something else.
