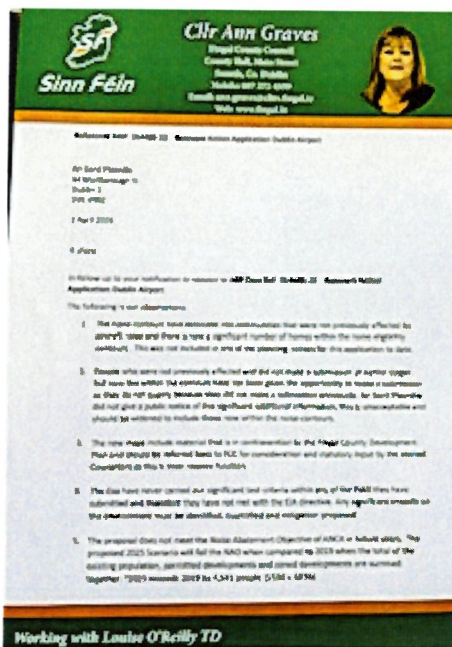

In Reference to your notification in relation to **REF Case Ref: 210402-02** **Reservoir Action Application Public Report**

The following is the information:

- The new reservoir has been extended into communities that were not previously affected by the reservoir and there is now a significant number of homes within the public water supply catchment. This was not included in any of the previous reports for the reservoir in this area.
- People who were not previously affected by the reservoir did not have a submission at earlier stages but now live within the reservoir catchment and have been given the opportunity to make a submission. As they do not qualify because they do not make a submission at this stage, all the time they did not get a public notice of the significant additional information, this is unacceptable and they are not allowed to submit their time within the reservoir.
- The new reservoir has been extended into communities that were not previously affected by the reservoir and there is now a significant number of homes within the public water supply catchment. This was not included in any of the previous reports for the reservoir in this area.

- The proposal does not meet the Reservoir Assessment Objective of RAO4 in future years. The proposed 2025 forecast will fail the RAO4 water compared to 2018 when the total of the existing population, permitted developments and current developments are assumed together. 2025 exceeds 2018 by 4.44% (2025 = 10.14% v 2018 = 5.70%).

6. The fire should be required to submit actual noise results along the right paths from the North runway which has been in operation since August 2022.
7. **Category 1 noise to the noise zones of Stage Development Plan.** These noise zones must now be revised due to the proposed right path. **Original County Council consider that noise should have remained, they rejected it.** It is now noise A as it is considered harmful to health as it was considered unacceptable due to the right path of proposed development. **However, the right path now being operated by GAA exporting rugby training residences in noise zone A and B which is just not acceptable from a health point of view.**
8. The noise insulation grant proposed is not suitable to protect residents for night noise. **On basis of the measurements of noise in bedrooms in homes already insulated it shows that the noise will exceed the recommendations in the Stage Development Plan and are not sufficient to protect the health and wellbeing of residents.**
9. Planning is not a decision for the club. They do not have planning registration or decisions made by AED. They are a semi state body who lobby government ministers and TDs and they should be treated like any other individual or organisation and comply with conditions attached to planning.
