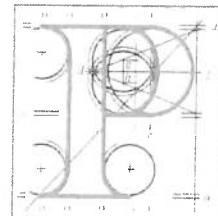

Dear Sir/Madam

I make this submission in response to the recent notification I received from An Bord Pleanála

- 1) I would submit that the new maps now contain material contraventions to both the Fingal and Meath County Council Development Plans and must be referred back to those bodies for statutory input by councillors into what is a reserved function retained by elected councillors.
- 2) Many people are now within contours regarding which they have not been given the opportunity to make a submission/observation on the basis that did not make a submission previously as they thought they were unaffected. An Bord Pleanála did not give a public notice of this significant additional information. The above is totally unacceptable and unjust to the communities affected.
- 3) As someone who has had their home insulated I can definitively say that the noise insulation provided has not been fit for purpose.
- 4) Basically, the DAA has sought to maintain a corporate mentality from its Aer Rianta period where airport related development did not require planning permission. Their actions show that they do not respect planning legislation or decisions of An Bord Pleanála. This application must be refused.
- 5) I would further request that the submission made by the St. Margaret's, The Ward Residents group be considered to reflect my views and be held to be a part of this submission
