Further to your correspondence **bus on** the above case we wish**to make the** . following observations/submissions:

- 1. We are shocked to see that the moistontours have extended hugely intour community and that a very significant number of dwellings are now included within thinoise eligibility contour in Firstly, we note that there was no induce of this fact in any of the planning of ces for this application to date. May of our neighboursario thought the were not affected by this applicationer now inside these contours but yet were never publiq notified until they attended a public mortingful by St. Margarets /The Ward reidents* group who explained this to all of us. None of the newspaper or site notions informed by public. Secondly the people who now know they are within the contours have not been given the opportunity to make a submission/observation as they do not qualify because they divinor make a submission previously as they though they were unaffected. Bord Pleanâla did not give a public notice of this significant additional information. The above is totally unacceptable and unjust to the communities affected.
- 2. We note that the correspondence from Tom Phillips & Associates refers to the ANCA Regulatory Decision regarding eligibility to the note insulations theme and suggesthat the change in contours is as a result of their assessing that the increased area is as a result of their assessing that the increased area is as a result of them considering this new area which contains dwellings to having "very significant effects. We note that the DAA have never carried out significant test criteria withlining of the LAR they have submitted and therefore they have not met with the EIA directive. This is fundamental flaw in the assessment as the EIA directive is clear, all significant impact on environmental state is dentified, quantified and mitigation proposed that has not happened to date. - 3. Tom Phillips refers continuously to the regulatory decision by ANCA in his correspondence. However, what is not contained in his correspondence but is within the EIAR relating to these noise contours is that the proposal does NOT neet the Noise Abstervent Objective of ANCA in future years. The proposed 2025 Scenario will fail the NAO when compared to 2019 when the total of the existing population, permitted developments and zoned developments are summed together. "2025 exceeds 2019 by 4,541 people (1533 v 6074).
- 4. Why have the noise contours growe? St Margarets The Ward residents carried out noise monitoring on the north runway flight path and found the noise levels to be far beyond those PREDICTED by DAA. Their noise predictions are not accurate and unfounded and they are trying to obtain permission by manipulating numbers. Why can they not submit actual noise results along the flight path which has been in operation since August 2022? The community could. community could.
- Reference is made to the hoise zones on Fingal development plan. These noise zones must now be revised due to the proposed fight path over our area. Fingal County Council now oe revised due to the proposed more part part over our area. Pangar country countr
- 6. The exist insulation grant as proposed is not fit for purpose and is totally insufficient to grotect for night noise. Measurements of noise in bedrooms of housing already insulated indicate that the noise levels exceed the recommendation in Fingal Development Plan are not sufficient to protect human health.
- 7. In summary planning is an after thought for DAA. Their actions show that they do not respect planning legislation or decisions of An Bord Pleanalla. This application must be refused.
