Having read through the daa newly submitted documents, it is clear in the submission from daa, that they have used the current flight paths for their "permitted" drawings instead of the permitted noise zones from the original 2007 planning permission. They seem to be hoping that ABP grants this on the basis of the relatively small difference between before and after with respect to night flights.
