

We have lived in this area for 39 years and it is only in recent years the noise level at night has become a major issue, causing awakenings, loss of sleep and inability to get back to sleep and subsequent distress during the daytime due to tiredness.

The DAA are in breach of their planning and enforcement should be done as a matter of urgency. The documents they provided are irrelevant as planning has no role in the commercial gain or profitability of any enterprise. The noise reports and expert judgement state quite clearly there is no scientific evidence to show either way there is awakenings or not. The noise reports are useless and try to show no matter what they do the affected population will be the same. Averaged noise measurements are useless, peak noise is what causes awakenings. The DAA have displayed a high level of arrogance in trying to justify their blatant violations of planning and a total disregard for the effect on the impacted population.

You can access realtime flight path information eg. Flightradar24.com and it will show the high level of concentrated activity at certain time of day and night. I have recorded many flights that are landing with an elevation of about 1,000 ft over Kinsealy but the takeoff is about 3,000 ft over Kinsealy and is much noiser. I have measured beside our Home >66dB noise from takeoff using a calibrated Tadeto SL720 sound meter. We have installed special noise dampening windows with little effect.

I am sure everyone close to the flight paths are suffering at night due to the increase in night traffic, the low level of glide for Takeoff and landings and the subsequent noise and disturbances.

The night time limits need to be enforced until such time as it can be proven aircraft noise and flight paths with directed takeoff and approach glide paths will be significantly reduced in noise levels. Many flights can originate elsewhere in Ireland with no loss of economic benefit to Ireland.

An oral hearing is an absolute necessity to convince the DAA to solve their problem in a different way and stop this arrogant approach.
