

We are one of the many people effected by the noise from the new North Runway at Dublin Airport.

We live in Greenogue Kilsallaghan (K67D650). Our home and garden have been greatly impacted since the opening of the runway. We have at times flights flying directly over our home where we have lived for the last 40 years. We are concerned when our grandchildren come to visit and play outside with the amount of flights and noise, and also wondered what pollutants rain down on us from the jet engines. As we are now OAP's and retired, not having to face early mornings it is not possible to enjoy a lie in with flights starting from 6.30am and flying over us every 3 to 5 minutes. I recall when the new runway was spoken about, it was to have a flight path going out over Ballycullin before banking right which would have no impact on the Greenogue area. I have witnessed flights myself when they take off and immediately bank right which takes them on a path over St Margaret's, Colloquy and Greenogue. I don't think this is what the DAA received planning for.

I now understand that the DAA are now looking to change the planning and also want to extend the flight time's which we would strongly object to, as our quality of life has already been severely impacted.
