

I am a professional airline pilot and I am making an observation on the egregious contravention of planning committed by the DAA due to the flightpaths from the North runway at Dublin Airport.

The effect of extending the operating hours and moving to a noise quota system would be absolutely devastating for the mental health and well being of residents under and near the flightpaths.

It must be recognised that the flightpaths are vastly different from what was agreed. The people underneath them were never consulted because those paths were never planned in those directions. You must think of a flightpath as a roadway in the sky. The agreed roadways for planning are six kilometres from where they were given permission. If indeed the DAA were looking to build roads and they contravened planning in such a way it would never be allowed. The fact that the flightpaths are in the air does not change the principle.

My five year old boy wakes up every morning at 7 am when the first aircraft departs the north runway. The roar from the aircraft is unbearable. Modern aircraft are only slightly quiter, they are not silent. It will soon be the case that he is woken up at 6 am if these times are granted.

There is a solution. The DAA must compel Airnav Ireland to redesign the flightpaths. Until that happens there must be no changes to existing restrictions.

The current flightpaths bear no resemblance to what was planned or agreed on in the planning permission. On that basis no extensions to operating times should be given.
