

I am writing to express my serious concerns about the proposed plans for Dublin Airport, and specifically about the serious impact of noise from the operations of the Airport are having on my home and our family's enjoyment of our home and garden. There has been a significant increase in noticeable noise emissions from over-flying aircraft in recent months to the extent that we are regularly awoken from sleep in the early mornings, we are also ex[posed to high noise levels throughout the daytime, evening time and late into the nighttime from aircraft over-flying our home.

We have live in this house since 1982 and were well able to co-exist peacefully and quietly with the airport traffic until the new north runway was brought into service. However since the north runway was brought into service there have been a significant increase in the noise level from aircraft in our area. Low flying aircraft are now a regular feature, and many of them seem to be turning as they over-fly our home. This was seldom, if ever, the case in the past.

To help us to be relieved from this constant exposure to high noise levels I therefore ask that the Bord please refuse permission to Dublin Airport Authority for its current operating programme. Past experience shows that low noise airport traffic to and from Dublin Airport can be accommodated in a manner that will allow us residents to return to a "normal" relatively low noise environment where our health and our enjoyment of our home and property is not adversely affected by the operation of Dublin Airport.
