

The unauthorised flight being used by daa to fly over our home and village at Coolquay has proved to be a living nightmare.

We have counted the flights going over our house on a number of occasions. For example, on Friday the 15th September from 7am to 11am 78 aircraft flew over our house. The noise at times can be truly unbearable.

The effect of daily and nighttime flights will be detrimental to our physical and mental wellbeing. This is a most callous and unfair treatment to inflict on people.

There is a solution to the problem. The daa can

- use the flight paths as per the original planning permission.
- Straight out flight paths, mirroring operations on the south runway
- Aircraft can climb faster at take off (Noise abatement) reducing noise by flying higher over our homes

These methods have been highlighted to the daa on a number of occasions We consider that the daa has behaved in an arrogant and callous manner toward us and our community.

Dublin Airport is a major national infrastructure and is important to our country. However, it is unjust to allow the Airport to endanger our community. Should the matter remain unresolved, we believe it is the responsibility of the Government to step in to protect the health and wellbeing of the community, which is the primary duty of our Government.
