I am a person who has found myself after 36 years living and working in this area to be adversely affected by the operation of an illegal flightpath since the opening of the North Runway. It is bewildering to me how the flightpaths in use today are so different to what was agreed in the 2007 planning permission. I cannot understand how this is allowed by FCC or An Bord Pleanala. I operate a small scale furniture manufacturing business in a workshop behind my home (which I obtained planning permission for) and consequently spend a lot of time on the phone with either customers or suppliers. This has become increasingly difficult due to the continuous loud noise from the aircraft overhead.

The quality of my life has also been affected in other ways due to the interference in my sleep, with being woken up regularly by the loud noise and the relentless nature of the continuous flights overhead. During the day I have to keep my windows closed if listening to the radio as otherwise I will miss large sections of the content due to the noise from the planes.

I also enjoy spending time in my garden with my grandchildren and have noticed how difficult this has become as we navigate the continuous loud background noise.

I strongly believe that that the flightpaths should be changed back to what was proposed in 2007 and within that context other changes may be considered, depending on the consequences and experiences of residents in the area affected.

An oral hearing is absolutely necessary given the gravity of the situation.
