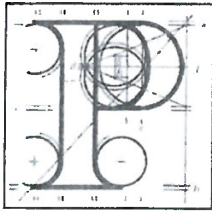

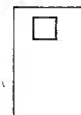

I am now living under an illegal flightpath since the 24/8/2022. The flightpaths in the 2007 planning permission are much different to the ones used today and since it opened.

The noise from the flightpaths currently in use is intolerable. As I am not permitted to change anything at my residence without proper planning permission, I would ask why is Bord Pleanála allowing this unauthorised use of the flightpaths??

Apart from the noise levels which are completely intolerable, we are not breathing any clean air anymore. The smoke or evaporation fuel hangs in the air all the time which proves that the data that was shared publicly at COP 28 that Dublin Airport is the biggest place in Ireland for the harmful emission of greenhouse gases in the entire country. As a result our enjoyment of our home and garden has been severely impacted since the opening of the North Runway. The current operation is causing huge distress and disturbance for tens of thousands of people not to mention the negative health effects and illnesses which can be attributed to excessive aircraft noise.
