

Following numerous complaints from residents about a consistent breach of planning permission regarding the number of night-time flights at Dublin Airport, Fingal County Council in July 2023 issued an enforcement notice on the Dublin Airport Authority (DAA) to reduce the number of night flights at Dublin Airport to a maximum of 65 between 11pm and 7am.

Following on from this, the DAA is seeking to change the regulations on night-time flights. This would remove the cap on the number of night-time flights and replace it with a noise quota system. It would also extend day-time hours by 2 hours, from 7am to 11pm, to 6am to midnight.

I understand that the DAA's argument is that quieter planes would fly at night-time. However, there is concern among residents that these changes would simply result in more flights waking them up throughout the night and early morning hours.

I live in close proximity to Dublin Airport and I consider myself fortunate to have this amenity on my doorstep. The Airport is a vital resource to our community and provides huge opportunities and employment. However, the DAA should not be in breach of its planning permission, and this has caused a level of distrust among certain communities.
