

I am one of over 30,000 people who are now living under an illegal flightpath since the opening of the North Runway. The 2007 planning condition documentation includes flightpath assumptions which many people have built their lives around. The flightpaths in the 2007 planning permission are much different to the ones in use today and since it opened.

The noise from the current flightpaths is intolerable. I live in an older house with no modern insultation or double glazed windows. Although I am now directly under the new flightpaths, I am not within the areas that were insulated as these are under the 2007 flightpaths that were approved. These flightpaths must be changed back to what was proposed in 2007. No further changes can be considered until this crucial issue is addressed first.

There is a major health risk to tens of thousands of people due to excessive aircraft noise.

An oral hearing is absolutely necessary given the gravity of the situation.
