



for Residents in the Fingal area and it doesn't make any sense given how serious the everent noise situation is. Noise from rurkent flight paths is intolerable. Noise from rurkent flight paths is intolerable, the negative health effects which can be attributed to excessive aireraft moise are well documented. Switching to a pure moise quota system for might-time flights will inevitably result in more serious sleep disturbance for residents with no limits on the number of night flights. Night flights should be banned as is the ease in other major airports. The cap on might flights must be maintained at the very least. An oral hearing is absolutely necessary given the gravity and urgancy of the situation.
