



I have been living here with my wife and family for the past 34 years.

We have been blessed to live in a beautiful locality. During that time development has taken place in the area, which was in compliance with planning conditions.

Our lives changed in February of this year with the opening of the North Runway. I have come to realise that I am living under an illegal flight path which is not in compliance with Planning Conditions granted in 2007. The noise from aircraft is utterly intolerable and is having a negative impact on my health.

Some examples of how I am affected in my home and property.

The intrusive noise of low flying planes directly over our house on a repetitive basis has been a shock to all.

I have found it impossible to hold conversations in the garden. This also applies when I am on the telephone.

Windows in our house must remain closed at all times to help deal with the noise. This was particularly upsetting during the Summer, causing my family huge distress.

It has come to my notice that the DAA has submitted new documents to An Bord Pleanala in an effort to have the flight paths (currently used illegally) legitimised almost as an oversight. These illegal flight paths are a critical element of the DAA action submission and must be considered within it.

The DAA must revert to flight paths granted by Fingal Co. Council in 2007 which will largely deal with the noise issue. Planes will not have to use extra thrust as they turn, thereby creating more noise, as they do presently.

In conclusion my major areas of concern are:

- The DAA is not using the flightpaths granted in its 2007 planning permission.
- The DAA has breached the passenger cap in 2019 and will most likely do so again.
- The DAA is consistently breaching the 65 flight movement cap per night.

It is my firmly held belief that an oral hearing is absolutely necessary given the gravity of the situation.
