

I wish to raise strong objections to the DAA request to change the Day Hours and to remove the night-time cap of 65 flights per night.

The flight paths over Portmarnock, since the opening of the new runway, and the increased amount of night time flights are making and will make an even more significant impact on my family.

It is impossible to sleep with the windows open, as we have been accustomed to for fresh air and quality of sleep.

Even with the windows closed, which we are forced into now, the sleep of the whole family is constantly disrupted by the noise of aircraft particularly around midnight to 2am and again frequently from 4:30am, with flight noise repeatedly occurring every 2 minutes at times.

This constant waking and disturbance is impacting on our health and wellbeing and even in sleep is causing stress responses to the sudden noises throughout the night. The disrupted sleep is affecting the family's ability in the daytime to study and to perform our jobs. Leading to stress and impact on quality of life.

We would strongly wish to see the flightpaths and conditions revert to those approved in the 2007 planning permission.
