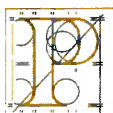

Dear Secretary,

I am one of the over 30,000 people who are now living under an illegal flightpath since the opening of the North Runway. Just 3 months ago we moved into the new home that we spent many years planning and building for ourselves and our 4 young children on Kinsealy Lane.

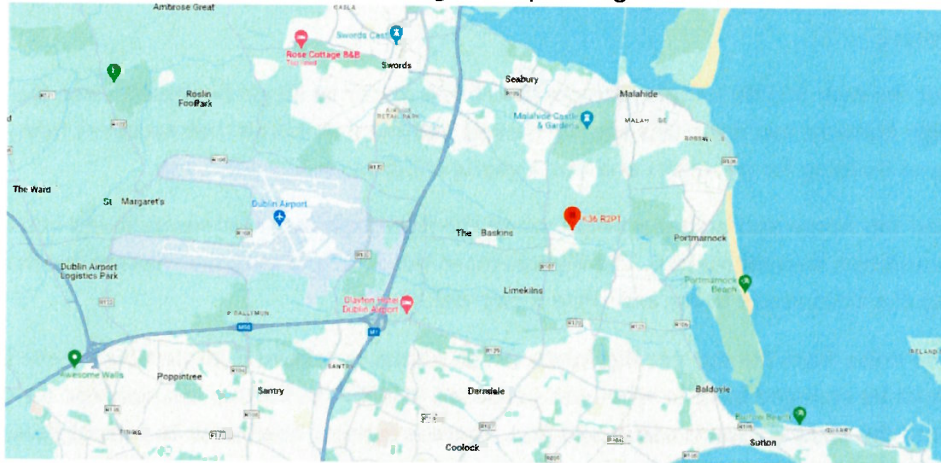
We planned this home and built our lives around the flightpath assumptions included in the 2007 planning condition documentation. The flightpaths in the 2007 planning permission are much different to the ones in use today and since it opened.

- The noise from the current flightpath which passes overhead is intolerable. These **flights must be changed back** to what was proposed in 2007. No further changes can be considered until this crucial issue is addressed first. There is a major health risk to tens of thousands of people due to excessive aircraft noise and fumes.
- **These images were taken from our front door of our new home on the afternoon of the 5th of November 2023.** The noise was unbearable.





- **Google map** showing our location (Eircode K36 R2P1) in proximity to the runway. The flight path should be further north according to the planning documentation.



- I am **terrified** for the health of my 4 young children aged 3, 5, 6 and 7 years old. I opened the windows in my children's bedrooms the other morning to allow some fresh air into the home but had to close them immediately due to the incredibly strong smell of aviation fuel coming through the window. We have a right to be able to open the windows in our home freely and without worry due to noise and pollution.
- Our **enjoyment of the home and garden has been severely impacted** since the opening of the North Runway. My children cannot enjoy playing in the garden due to the severe noise. We cannot have family gatherings in the fresh air in the garden as we cannot hear each other speak due to the noise.
- I am **woken during the night and early in the morning** due to excessive aircraft noise. This is affecting my mood and my family relationships and is proving detrimental to my health and mental health.
- Unlimited night flights using a pure noise system is only going to cause more sleep disturbances for residents. Night flights should be banned as is the case in many other major airports.

An oral hearing is absolutely necessary given the gravity of the situation.
