

 - The use of unapproved flight paths since the opening of the north runway at Dublin airport is the main reason why so many people are being unnecessarily exposed to dangerous levels of aircraft noise.
 - 2) Increasing the number of daytime hours for aircraft to land and take off from Dublin airport's north runway, will outomatically prolong the noise exposure of those people who live in proximity to the unauthorised flight paths.
 - 3) An unlimited number of night flights on Dubling airport's north runway, in the context of extended daytime hours effectively leaves residents along the unapproved flight path vulnerable to harmful levels of aircraft noise 24/7.
