## **Observation arguments:**

- 1. The daa want to use the North Runway for an additional 2 hours at night, 23:00-24:00 and 06:00-07:00, resulting in its use from 06:00-24:00. This amends Condition 3(d) of planning. Note the Inspector recommended to refuse permission, and only with the addition of Conditions 3(d) and 5 did ABP approve the North Runway's planning.
- 2. The daa want to get rid of the 65 flights nighttime restriction (Condition 5) and replace it with a Noise Quota System (NQS) which will facilitate unlimited flights on the South Runway impacting residents in Dublin West.
- 3. There has been a severe lack of consultation and many homes have been built since the last public consultation in 2016.
- 4. The public notice is incorrect and states that "Condition 3(d) and 5 have not come into effect as the construction of the North Runway on foot of the North Runway Planning Permission is ongoing", which is not true as the North Runway is built.
- 5. Also the public notice mentions nothing about a change in flight paths since the North Runway's permission was granted in 2007.
