Boliden Tara Mines (BTM) is submitting an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) as a result of third-party planning appeal (Ref: ABP315173-22). During consideration of the appeal ABP deemed that a mandatory Environmental Impact assessment (EIA) process was required.

BTM propose to construct a reinforcement buttress to sections of the extant Tailings Storage Facility (TSF) in the townlands of Randalstown, Simonstown and Sillogue, Navan, Co. Meath. The proposed development is to be undertaken with a view to increasing the stability of the structure in line with recent enhancements of industry standards (Global Industry Standard on Tailings Management).
