Expression of Interest Saint Vincent De Paul Transport Subcontract Re: Clothes Collections/Deliveries subcontract for the North East & Midlands Region

SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL (SVP) will be launching a tender in March/April 2024 for the above-named subcontract. The subcontract is in relation to the requirement of transport services within the (North East and Midlands) NEM region for the collection and delivery of pre-used textiles and other items within the SVP shop and clothing bank network.

At the present time the network includes 38 Vincent's charity shops and 80 clothing banks.

Overview:

A minimum of two and maximum of six vans and drivers will be required for the provision of this service. (Further information/clarification will be provided on receipt of Expression of Interest.)

The sub-contract will initially be for one year.

The main base of operation will be the Order Fulfillment Centre (OFC).

The OFC is located in Drogheda, Co Louth. Transport services will be provided to the shops and clothing banks from the OFC and from the shops and banks to the OFC.

The shops and banks are in various locations over the North East and Midland region. Counties included are Louth, Monaghan, Cavan, Meath, Westmeath and Longford. A full list of all shops and clothing banks will be provided. The Regional Council is responsible for the financial and operational oversight of the NEM region.

SVP will request the number of vans depending on the need and number of items to be collected/delivered on a daily basis and can increase or decrease according to requirements.

Your tender will need to strictly adhere to the conditions laid out within the application pack which will be provided on receipt of the Expression of Interest.

The intention is that the structure and content of the application pack will substantially form the S.L.A. (Service Level Agreement) that binds SVP to an outsourced provider.

The tenderer will bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the tender.

SVP will in no case be responsible or liable for such costs, whatever the conduct or outcome of the procedure.

The final closing date for submission of Letters of Interest will be the 22nd February, 2024.

The team responsible for determining the chosen party will be nominating diary dates in the period that will allow you to meet the team to discuss the I.T.T. (Invitation to Tender) information pack in detail.

The awarding of the subcontract to the successful party(s) will be communicated by the NEM regional office.
