An appeal has been made to An Bord Pleanála against the decision made on 27th October 2022 by Meath County Council, bearing the above planning reference number which decision was to grant permission with conditions to Boliden Tara Mines DAC for the construction of a reinforcement buttress to the extant embankment walls of the Tailings Storage Facility. The development works will consist of the construction of a rockfill and earthen reinforcement buttress to sections of the extant embankment walls of the Tailings Storage Facility at Randalstown, Simonstown and Sillogue, Navan, Co. Meath.

Following a notice requiring submission of an EIAR.

Any such submissions or observations must be accompanied by the statutory fee of **€50**, unless the submissions or observations are made by certain prescribed bodies or existing participants, and should be addressed to The Secretary, An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1.

The EIAR will be submitted to An Bord Pleanála within 2 weeks of this notice being published.
