The designated development consists of the installation and operation of temporary emergency electricity generating plant comprised of eight 35 MW gas turbine generators and associated ancillary electrical and mechanical equipment. Construction of the designated development will include site preparation including dismantling/ demolition, civil and ancillary works and temporary contractor's working areas and installation of the electricity generating plant.
