

Thank you for your recent letter on the 23rd February 2024.

I hereby resend my objections as per the below to the planned bus stop out side 95 Rathfarnham Road, D14 WR82.

However I want to add in this point.

We believe a bus stop at this location is extremely dangerous. Cyclists fly down that road as it is on a decline and this will only get worse when they get the dedicated cycle track. Placing a bus top here will cause a lot of crashes of bikes into pedestrians including school children as they get on and off the bus due to it being on a hill.

It makes way more sense to leave it where it currently is just across the road at the Dodder Bridge, Current Bus stop 1334. Here there is a slight upwards hill so cyclists will not be at full pace as they get going after the traffic lights and so it will be much less likely that they will crash in to and seriously hurt people.

Original submission below:

We recently bought and moved into our house at 95 Rathfarnham Road. We would like to object to the new bus stop being placed outside our house under the plans for the new Bus Corridor.

We feel there is no need to move the bus stop from its existing place at Dodder Bridge, Bus Stop 1334, where it is currently placed. This is a non-residential area and so the best place for the bus stop and so leaving the bus stop here makes more sense. It is also only about 100 meters from the new place they want to put the bus stop outside 95 Rathfarnham Road so less than a minute further to walk, which is nothing.

Leaving the bus stop here would not impact a residential house and family living here. We have a young family and are very nervous of the anti-social behaviour / noise and groups gathering, graffiti that can happen at bus stops. Also, the people smoking at bus stops and dropping their litter.

This stop would also be very close to the traffic lights at the end of a hill, on a very busy road and so placing the bus stop after the traffic lights where it is currently located at Dodder Bridge is a much safer place to have it for pedestrians, young children going to school and cyclists who will have time to slow down at the traffic lights and restart their journey again after pausing at the traffic lights.

I would like it noted that we object to the placement of a new bus stop outside 95 Rathfarnham Road and ask for it to remain where it is at Bus stop 1334.
