

I refer to your letter to me from Eimear Reilly, dated 230224, imviting me to make an email submission in relation to the NTA's submission of the 20th December 2023.

In their submission the NTA reference their response to my submission as contained within section 2.2.3 of their submission.

I have reviewed section 2.2.3 of their submission as it relates to my submission and now wish to make a submission in accordance with your invitation,

Section 2.2.3.2 response to issues raised. d. Effectiveness of proposed turn bans, page 74.

In this section the NTA acknowlege the comments in relation to enforsement of the right turn ban onto Greenlea Road. The NTA acknowlege that camera based enforement by the Garda will be required but then go on to outline the proposed setting up of a working group to undertake the first phase of this action. The working group would be tasked with making recommendations as to how camera enforsement might be introducted. It is stated that only after the receipt of these recommendations that the Department of Transport will determine subsequent steps required including addressing legislative issues.

Clearly it will be many years after introduction of the ban on the right hand turn before all these steps are implemented and camera inforcement is in place. As carmeras are suggested as the only practical enforcement action I contend that there will be years where this right hand turn sign will be ignored and that all the city bound traffic diverted down Fortfield road will take that right hand turn at Greenlea Road as it will be the quickest alternative for them continue towards he city.

In my origional submission I made two suggestions to acheive enforcement of this right hand turn onto Greenlea Road. The first was to alter the road layout at the intersection of Greenlea Road and Forthfield Road so as to make the right hand turn very difficult or impossible. The second enforcement option I identified was to close the Fortfield Road Greenlea Road intersection to cars by erecting temporary Bollards. This could be done very cheaply and could be reversed if after a period of time residents wanted..

Having read section 2.2.3.2 of the NTAs submission I am disappointed to see that neither of my suggested enforcement actions were identified, considered and responded to. In the light of their identification that camera enforcement of the right hand turn ban will be required, but that it is some years away, I think other more immediated enforcement steps will be required.

I therefore request that my two options for enforcement be considered.
