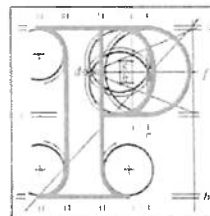

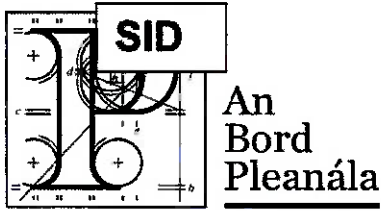

As a resident of Woodview Cottages with two primary school children and having lived with an active construction compound on the green space adjacent to my home since 2019 to facilitate the Dodder Greenway project, I wish to object to the continued/extended use of the Woodview Cottage Green space on the following grounds:

1. Wildlife - To use the whole of the green space as a construction site would impinge on the natural habitat of our local wildlife (Bats, foxes, badgers, birds) to a detrimental extent. Equally, the risk of contaminants from such a large construction site may have very negative effects on the local rivers. Has an environmental survey been completed?
2. Road Safety - There is a constant flow of heavy vehicles already from the existing site. This is a concern for the many people (walkers, runners, cyclists) using the newly built greenway every day. Already there are large trucks mounting the cycle track in order to exit the construction site and I have a real concern that the proposed development would increase this traffic to a dangerous level.
3. Loss of green space for residents - As a parent, I have concerns over the safety of my children who currently go and play on the field. In

order to build the Dodder View Road, residents had to give up their garden space that originally extended to the Dodder River. In the absence of gardens, Woodview Cottage green has become a defacto garden space for residents and particularly children. After 2 years of Covid, it seems cruel to rob them of this space for the rest of their primary school days.

4. Public amenity - the field is used by the local children (especially when the daffodils in the middle of the field are in bloom), dogs, fitness organisations and enthusiasts, residents social events (eg annual picnic, flower planting) and recreational users throughout the year. To remove this unique space would be a real loss for the community.
5. Health - the levels of dust and other airborne pollutants has had a notable effect on residents. Likewise, the noise pollution is a constant stressor currently and would be exponentially worse should the whole space be turned into a construction compound.
6. Previously committed timeline - the initial project was only meant to run for a matter of months but ran over 2 years due to Covid. After the green field was repaired, the construction compound was rebuilt for the rest of the Dodder greenway and has been there since, which is already way beyond the expectation set by the council to the residents
7. Food prevention - the current space acts as a flood plain and since many residents of Woodview Cottages are unable to get flood protection on their home insurance policies, any increased risk of flooding is a serious concern to residents

8. Traffic management - The current construction site can at times already cause traffic to build up quite a distance in both directions, leading to traffic jams outside the back of Woodview Cottages which is very overlooked
9. Effect on current infrastructure - the Council has just completed an amazing project in the Dodder greenway: improved visual impact, improved paths, cycle track and road surface. This is at risk of being degraded should the proposed construction compound and associated heavy vehicle traffic go ahead.
