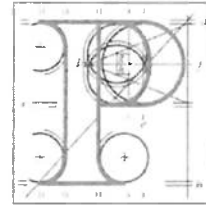

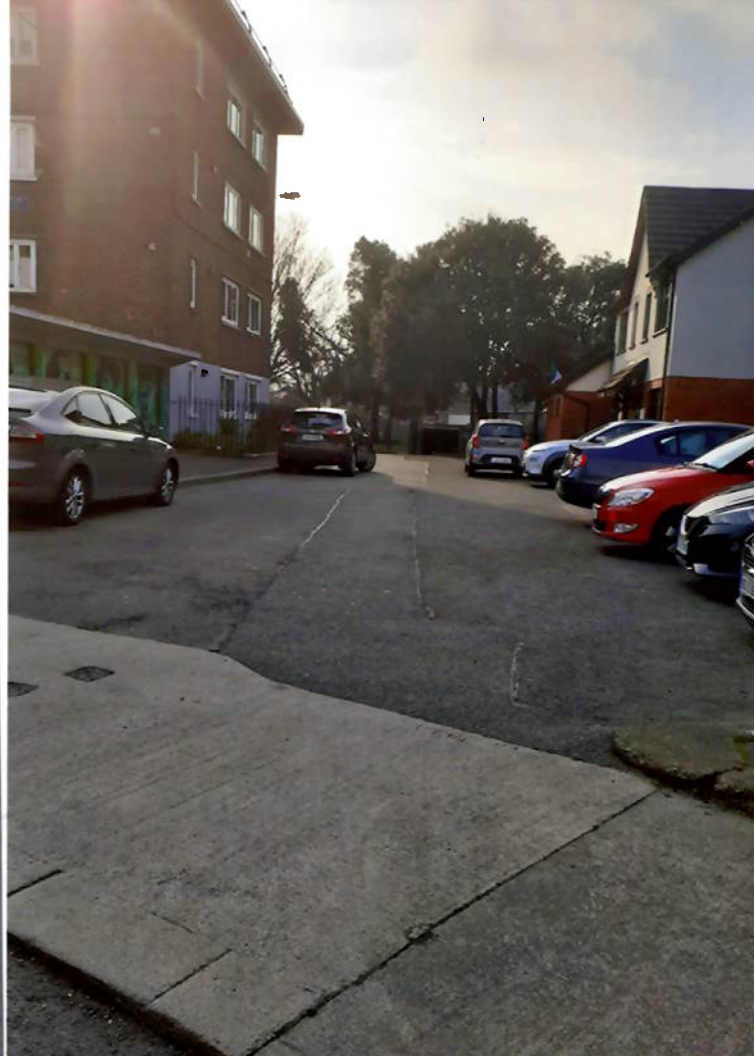
I would like to submit this petition against a cycle track going through Ringsend Park, The plan to build a bridge across the gut from Sir John Rogerson's Quay to York road in Ringsend for a bus corridor and cycle track, This track is to stop at the top of Pembroke Cottages where I live, the width of the road is about seven meters with parking on each side, We have no front or back gardens so our children and grandchildren play on the road. Not long ago one of the children was knocked down by a cyclist coming through an No Entry Zone this is on report with the Garda in Irishtown, we have cars and cyclist speeding through, some cycle on the footpath, we are in danger coming out our front doors. Cambridge Road is the main access road to Ringsend boys and girls school, Ringsend Technical College, an Old Folks Home plus a Women's Refuge, you have to cross this road to gain access to the park, the entrance is at a flat complex Cannon Mooney Gardens, and Cambridge Park, about three meters from this entrance there is another gate at St Patrick's Villas which is off the main Ringsend Road this is where the Bus Stop is. There is plenty of activity with students and families going to school and playground, the other entrances are St Brendan's Cottages and Strasburg Terrance along these entrances there is a grass merge which they want to use for a cycle track, Digging up tress and plants also where residents and non-residents would not be safe entering just for the two minutes off their journey.

What I would like to recommend if you can continue along York Road, Pidgeon House Road, to merge with the cycle track on Sean Moore Road. **WITH PHOTOS.**
