An Bord Pleanála has received your letter in which you intended to make an appeal under the Planning and Development Act, 2000, (as amended).

Your attention is drawn to section 130 of the Act, which provides that any person other than a party may make submissions to the Board in relation to an appeal. The development is the subject of another valid appeal against the planning authority's decision. Your submissions can be considered provided they are submitted with a fee of €50 in accordance with section 130(1)(c)(v) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, (as amended). Your submissions must be lodged within the appropriate period for the making of observations. In this case the period is 4 weeks beginning on the day of receipt by the Board of the appeal. The Board received the appeal on 7th March 2024.

Please note that the fee of €220 which you lodged will issue under separate cover, shortly. The appeal documentation which you submitted is being returned to you to facilitate resubmission of this appeal with the correct fee. Should you intend resubmitting the appeal to the Board, you must submit the required fee of €220 notwithstanding the fee refund which is currently pending from the Board's offices. You should further note that if your appeal does not conform with section 127 of the 2000 Act, including the submission of the appeal fee, it will be deemed invalid.

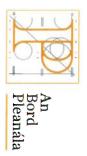
