RE: Railway Order Application – Elimination of Level Crossings Dublin / Cork line


Dear Mr. Browne,

I refer to your letter of 26th March 2021 seeking the consent of the National Transport Authority for Coras Iompair Éireann to submit an application to An Bord Pleanála for a Railway Order in respect of the replacement of the following seven manned level crossings on the Dublin-Cork railway line:

- XC187 – Fantstown;
- XC201 – Thomastown;
- XC209 – Ballyhay;
- XC211 – Newtown;
- XC212 – Ballycoskery;
- XC215 – Shinanagh; and
- XC219 – Buttevant.
