I have been asked by the Board to refer to the above-mentioned appeal.

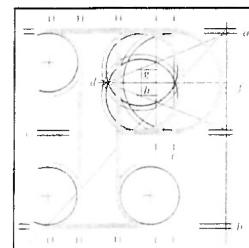
Having regard to article 28(1)(c) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 to 2009 and the proximity of the proposed development to recorded monuments e.g. CL039-0115 Ringfort. Also having regard to Article 28 (1)(n) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 to 2009 and the close proximity to Natura 2000 sites e.g. Mid Clare Coast Special Area of Conservation. The Board is of the opinion that it is appropriate in the interests of justice to request you to make submissions or observations to it.

In accordance with section 131 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, you are requested to make any submissions or observations you have in relation to the appeal in the context of the matter referred to in the above-mentioned article. The Board cannot consider submissions or observations that are outside the scope of that matter. Your submission in response to this notice must be received by the Board not later than **5.30 p.m. on 3rd October, 2011.**

If no submissions or observations are received before the end of the specified period, the Board will proceed to determine the appeal without further notice to you, in accordance with section 133 of the 2000 Act.

The planning application, along with other documents relating to the planning authority decision and copies of the appeal(s) made to the Board are available for inspection at the offices of the planning authority in accordance with section 38 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 and article 68 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001.
