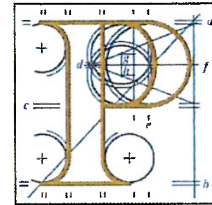

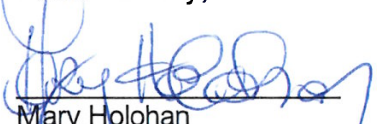
I have been asked by An Bord Pleanála to refer to your letter dated 24th September 2021 in relation to the above-mentioned appeal.

We act on behalf of McMahon Finn Wind Acquisitions Limited.

As you are aware, some three years ago, by Order of the Supreme Court dated the 30th July 2018, this Planning Application was remitted to An Bord Pleanála to be determined in accordance with law as interpreted in the Judgment of the Supreme Court. By letter dated the 18th December 2019, An Bord Pleanála requested Submissions which were delivered before the deadline of January 23rd 2020.
