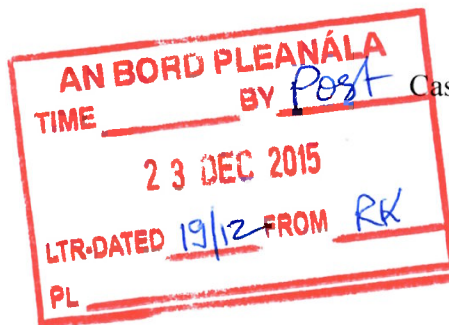

I would like to raise an objection fro the following planning reasons.

In terms of the visual impact I understand that they cannot be sure of the real levels of impact due to bad photographs provided in the EIS report. I live in the area and can assure you that the impact will be huge from all angles of the locality, the 4 turbines already in the area can be seen from every angle, Macroom and as far as the Millstreet road..... from the Clonakilty road before Enniskeane and coming from Cork before the Coachford turning 6 more will only add to this as they are right next door. Visual impact will be devastating. Although I can't see that the planners in Cork County are concerned with is at all.

Noise levels are another point I am finding very concerning I have a young family and already have an impact on them from the existing 4 let alone 6 more and larger. I am told the levels of noise will not be known until the model is clarified but again the Cork Planners do not seem to have taken this into account. I have lived in this area all my life and noise barely existed before the existing wind farm was constructed ...

I can only ask that for my family's sake and our neighbors that you do not give acceptance to this plan as it will only seek to ruin an area of both natural Irish beauty and a community which is steeped in historical importance.
