We would like to express our concerns about the proposed development by Barna Wind Energy Ltd. We have already lodged objection on 30-01-2015 to Cork County Council on this proposed development as described below (Please find embedded below a copy of the objection lodged on the above date)

"We are lodging an objection to the proposed development of a wind turbine farm at Barnadivane, Terelton and in Lackareagh and Garranereagh, Lissarda by Barna Wind Energy (BWE) Ltd. We wish to do so for the following reasons as outlined below.

1. **Aesthetic factors:** When we will look out our kitchen window, we would be looking directly at these wind turbines towering into the skyline on the horizon. We believe that these would create an unnecessary eyesore. It would spoil our beautiful view of the countryside and the wonderful scenery we currently enjoy. Has enough of our picturesque Irish landscape being destroyed already?
2. **Pollution factors:** The noise level generated by these turbines is unbearable as many people living near existing turbines in this area will tell you. Some have constant headaches from the noise. This suffering should not be inflicted on anyone. In 2012 the Noise and Health journal published results from a US survey which compared sleeping patterns. The study suggested that the sleeping of people

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living within a mile of a wind farm was directly impacted by the operation of the turbines.

3. **Health factors:** In addition to the health risks posed by noise there may be other negative effects on health caused by the construction of wind turbines by Barna Wind Energy. There would be a shadow flicker effect generated by these turbines as they would be located directly between our house and the rising sun. This could have severe impact on us and our family's health. In 2007 World Health Organisation stated that a "bad view out of window" increases the risk of depression by 40%.
4. **Financial factors:** Should we decide to sell our home and farm in the future, this wind farm could have a severe impact of their value. One of the major selling points of our home and farm currently is the quiet setting and scenic views.

We hope that you will take into consideration the concerns and points raised by us in this letter."

We would like to once more express our objections as listed above to this proposed wind farm development. We had objected to An Bord Pleanála regarding the **CLASHAVOON-DUNMANWAY Power Line** (Ref No 04. VA0010) **which is** being built over our farm but to no avail.

We will have an ugly Pylon and 3 sets of double poles inflicted on us to view out our kitchen window. Not a pretty sight, thanks to An Bord Pleanála. EirGrid have scraped the proposed Cork-Dublin link as they can increase the power on their existing lines. Pity they didn't discover this sooner rather than building a power line here that is not necessary and unrequired.

We feel that we will have enough eyesores in our sight without inflicting more ugly turbines on the horizon of our view.

We hope that you will take into consideration the concerns and points raised by us in this letter.
