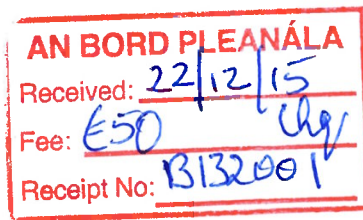

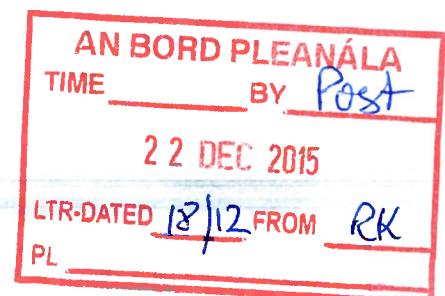
I would like to raise an objection from the following planning reasons.

I have read the numerous reports regarding the planning and have come to the conclusion that this plan will without doubt be of a significant visual impact

Firstly, in terms of the visual impact it clearly states in several instances in both the primary and the further reports that they cannot be sure of the real levels of impact due to bad photomontages and despite these being resubmitted it appears they are very contradictory with regards to allocating the levels of impact Stating low levels where they can only surmise they will see just the tops of the proposed turbines and again low when they surmise they would see the existing 4 turbines AND the planned 6 turbines ... how can this be? Surely the impact is a lot more substantial where more can be seen?

Secondly and most disturbing the point regards the noise levels. This cannot in anyway be confirmed as the model of turbine has not yet been clarified and with a request for a 10 year planning I would imagine this will never be confirmed as over the years the models will change as would the noise output. This in an area where noise barely exists would be huge... there is already has already been a very noticeable impact from the existing wind farm which I feel has not been taken adequately into account along with the other planning application for a huge sub station adjacent to the proposed wind farm and the already existing turbines.

I also feel that the mitigation measures is purely a phrase to basically say we will do something IF it is an issue once they are erected this is not sufficient as by then it will be too late for anything to be done and local residents will have to put up and shut up as is always the case with the wind farms..... This is nothing new but I would like to think that An Bord Plenala would look beyond the words and address the facts before allowing this further wind farm to be erected in this area.



I currently reside 2 miles from the existing wind farm and on a considerable number of occasions since it's construction have found myself living next to what can only be described as similar to a runway at an airport, what will it be like with 6 larger turbines (who's noise impact has yet to be quantified) and a sub station next door to them.

I am not going to bore you further with all the other points I have found in the reports that do not stack up as I am sure you have read numerous objection letters very similar to mine

I would ask you not for my own sake but for everyone in the area to assess this plan very carefully and while I assume you cannot review it in relation to the wind farm that exists and the substation I feel I need to make the point that all of these together will be a major impact to the area in every way.
