

I wish to make a written submission/observation in relation to:

Townlands of Camagh, Carlanstown, Coole, Clonrobert, Clonsura, Doon, Monktown, Mullagh, Newcastle and other townlands, Co. Westmeath.

Proposed development of up to 15 wind turbines with a tip height of up to 175 metres and laying of approximately 26km of underground electricity cabling to facilitate the connection to the national grid, and all associated site development works.

We urge that this Strategic Infrastructure Development Application be refused for the following reasons:

This proposal is not strategic. It is an illogical piecemeal step. The site is in the lee of mountains in the west of Ireland. Wind at the proposed site is inconsistent. As evidenced by the proposed 175 metre height of the wind turbines. The Irish Government should formulate a coherent nationwide plan for wind energy, not allow small inland sites owned by private companies. The logical and best site for large wind turbine farms is in the Atlantic Ocean off the west coast of Ireland. The damage to wildlife, the quality of life of nearby residents and the aesthetic blight on the landscape would be catastrophic, long lasting and irreparable.

The underground electric cabling connection to the National Grid would run directly past the two listed Gate Lodges to Levington Park. Under the listed building laws of Ireland no construction is permitted near these buildings. No communication, consultation or permission for works near these buildings or along the road, the underlying land and land on both sides, I own, has been received from the developers. The laying of a cable along this road would not allow me to leave my property during construction.

For these reasons I strongly object to the above proposal.
