I refer to the above.

We received a letter dated 3rd February 2023 from An Bord Pleanála by registered post on Tuesday 7th February 2023. The letter indicates that should we have any comments on the attachments to your letter these should be received by the Board by 23rd February. Attached to that letter was a submission received from the Air Corps requesting that an Aviation Impact Assessment be provided in support of the application. There was also a submission attached from South Dublin County Council relating to a number of clarifications requested including on site ownership, the potential for extending the redline, clarifications on existing operations, and a series of technical queries. We have in fact just over two weeks to respond.

I am writing to indicate that the chances of getting an expert to undertake an aviation impact assessment, have them appointed, have their work received, and have that included in a submission by 23rd February would be

extremely difficult and I am not at all sure that I would have this and potentially other requested information available for submission by 23rd February.

Can you please advise if there is any possibility of an extension?
