This application for further development of a quarry was lodged on 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 and was uploaded to the EIA Portal on 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2021.

The application was made within the appropriate time period and was initially validated with Brendan Wyse ADP, Muiriosa Cassells SEO and Mary Tucker EO on 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2021. The application, fee, notices and drawings appear to be adequate, however, the reporting inspector to consider adequacy of same along with EIAR and NIS,

A copy of the application for further development of a quarry issued to South Dublin County council on 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 and was received by the planning authority on 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2021.

The last date for receipt of report from the planning authority is 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2021. The planning authority did not respond within the statutory time period. A notice under section 132 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended) issued to South Dublin County Council requiring their report on the application and giving the last date for receipt of response as being on or before **18<sup>th</sup> August, 2021**.
