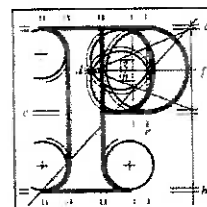



Further to the notification of further information in respect of the Direct Planning Application Remittal for the Greater Dublin Drainage Project, the Authority notes and supports the submission made by daa/Dublin Airport dated 05/06/2024 and respectfully requests that An Bord Pleanála give due consideration to the observations provided.

It is the observation of the Authority that should planning consent be granted, the applicant should be conditioned to engage with daa/ Dublin Airport to ensure that appropriate wildlife hazard reduction techniques and management is employed during the construction and subsequent operation of the site.

Furthermore, the applicant should be conditioned to notify daa/Dublin Airport and the air navigation service provider Air Nav Ireland of the intention to commence crane operations with at least 30 days prior notification of the erection.
